TENDERING PROCEDURES

1. All inquiries concerning the tender prior to tender closing shall be directed to:
Greg Gostick, Public Works Superintendent at (705) 389-2891
2. Notification of Acceptance of Tender will be by written form of notice to the address of the Contractor used on the bid forms. The Date of Acceptance shall be deemed to be the date of receipt of the Acceptance Notice by the Contractor.
3. A tender may be voided by superseding it with a later tender or letter of withdrawal, prior to the closing date and time.

TENDERING REQUIREMENTS

1. The successful bidder shall deliver a certified copy of the Firm's Public Liability and Property Damage insurance Policy for the works, within ten (10) calendar days of receiving the Acceptance Notice. Coverage shall be at least \$1,000,000 per accident. Failure to provide such proof may result in cancellation of the Contract. (Also see Form M-100 Subsections 106-1 and 106-2)
2. The successful bidder shall also deliver proof of Workplace Safety & Insurance Board coverage, within ten (10) calendar days of receiving the Acceptance Notice.
3. The successful bidder is considered to be the "constructor" as defined under the Health and Safety Act. Every employer and worker performing work must comply with this Act and regulations ensuring the health and safety of workers.

BASIS OF REJECTION OF TENDER

Tenders not conforming to the following requirements will be disqualified:

1. Tender must be legible, in ink, typewritten or by printer.
2. Tender must be in the possession of the Township of McKellar by the closing date and time.
3. Tender must be on Township form provided.
4. Tender must be signed and sealed by an authorized official of the bidding organization. A joint Tender must be signed and sealed by each Company. Envelope must be clearly marked "**TENDER – PW-2020-01-LC**".
6. Error in tender nullifies same.

1. The Contractor shall carry Liability Insurance in an amount of no less than \$1,000,000 to cover any possible claims by third parties. A copy of the policy shall be presented upon request to the Municipality. The policy must be continued in force for the duration of the work being performed.

2. Price quoted shall be per metric flake tonne minimum 35% calcium chloride, supplied and applied as per OPSS 506.
3. For products containing less than 35%, please state the chloride percent by mass (minimum 18%). Total Effective Chloride percentage _____%.

4. The work must be completed at a time agreeable to the Contractor and the Public Works Superintendent.
5. The product shall be supplied and applied on various roads throughout the Township as designated by the Public Works Superintendent at the unit price.
6. The vehicle supplied by the Contractor, for the application of the dust layer product, must be capable of accurately controlling the application rate of the product. The spray bar manifold must be capable of spraying over a variety of widths.
7. When applying the dust layer suppressant, all applicable Ministry of the Environment regulations shall be adhered to.
8. The quantity of dust layer suppressant is approximate only and may be increased or decreased by the Municipality without change to the unit price.
